Reef Guardians heads to Russia with Cousteau Team to free Orca and Beluga in Whale Jail.

RGH Founder, Harry Rabin, was invited to join the Cousteau Team and Whale Sanctuary Project to head first to Moscow, for diplomatic meetings, and then on to Vladivostok and the



infamous Srednyaya Bay in an effort to free 10 Orca and 87 Belugas held in the so-called Whale Jail.

The team was invited by both the Russian Ministry and the Governor of Vladivostok to assess the health of all the animals and determine if they could indeed be released back to the wild. Reef Guardians provided the team with an Infrared scope, Audio and video equipment, Drones and Hydrophones.

The Teams dedication and hard work led to an agreement in which the Governor of Vladivostok, ,stated the principal goal of rehabilitation and release. Subsequently, VNIRO, Russias equivalent to the United States Fish and Wildlife, recommended that there are no scientific reasons why the whales cannot be released, mirroring the Jean-Michel Cousteau/Whale Sanctuary Project team recommendations.
